



COUNCIL COMMUNIQUÉ – SEPTEMBER 2009

As summer slowly ends and fall begins, Council would like to update you on the projects and services within our beautiful town of Baie-D'Urfé.

Our Public Works Department will be picking up branches again this fall; please check the September newsletter for more details.

Tenders will be received in September for drainage work to be completed during September and October. This work is part of our master plan to improve drainage throughout the Town.

Our road refurbishing was continued this summer and the improvement on Surrey west of Morgan is a major one. Resurfacing work on several streets in the industrial sector was completed as well.

We are presently tendering for the professional service and engineering supervision for the next phase of the drainage program, to be done during the 2010-2014 years. Included in the plans for the 2010-2014 drainage program will be Surrey Road, east of Morgan, and the water-retention basin in the industrial sector.

The renovation work at Town Hall is proceeding well and we are planning to hold the final Council meeting of this mandate September 29th at Town Hall.

We will also be starting to prepare for the winter season. Remember the winter parking restrictions and also the driveway-entrance cleaning program for seniors. If you would like information, please call Town Hall at (514) 457-5324.

We are pleased with the building and completion of the new toilet facilities at the Fritz Community Centre and the installation of park/exercise equipment at Bertold and Picardy parks.

As winter approaches, the Town crews and contractors will be busy repairing many small problems throughout the Town. If you are aware of a problem pertaining to drainage, street lights, etc., please do not wait until frost – call Town Hall and report it so that it can be added to our work list.

Council is looking into the finalization of plans for the renovation of the Morgan Road entrance to Town. Following the public consultation meeting and considering the opinions of many citizens, we are preparing to choose a designer and landscape architect and budget the work to be done in 2010. We are planning to complete this project for the 100th anniversary of the incorporation of the Town of Baie d'Urfé in 2011.
