I invite you to read this brochure carefully. It contains essential information regarding nominations, the election period, advance voting, and election day procedures.

### ⚠ IMPORTANT DATES

- **Period to file a nomination paper:** From September 19 to October 3, 2025, until 4:30 p.m.
- **Advance voting day:** October 26, 2025, from 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- **Election day:** November 2, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

### RUNNING FOR OFFICE

Any person is eligible to run for municipal council if they have the right to be entered on the electoral list of the Town of Baie-D'Urfé and are a resident of Baie-D'Urfé at the time of filing their nomination.

Please note that some legal ineligibilities apply.

Anyone wishing to run for mayor or councillor must submit a nomination form to the Office of the Returning Officer between September 19 and October 3, 2025.

Office hours will be posted in the public election notice. **Exceptionally, on Friday, October 3, 2025, the office will remain open continuously from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.**

### ARE YOU ELIGIBLE TO VOTE?

To vote, you must meet the following conditions on election day:

- ✓ Be a Canadian citizen
- ✓ Not have lost your electoral rights
- ✓ Be 18 years of age or older
- ✓ Be entered on the electoral list
- ✓ Be domiciled in Baie-D'Urfé and have lived in Quebec for at least 6 months, or be the owner of a building or the occupant of a business establishment located in the Town for at least 45 days

### ARE YOU REGISTERED ON THE ELECTORAL LIST?

It is your responsibility to make sure that your name appears on the electoral list and that your information is correct.

The list may be consulted at Baie-D'Urfé Town Hall (20410 Lakeshore Road) during regular business hours starting on Friday, October 3, 2025.

### ⚠ IMPORTANT

Unlike federal elections, no application for registration or change of address can be made on-site on polling days.

### WHAT SHOULD YOU BRING TO VOTE?

You must present one of the following pieces of ID:


- Quebec driver's licence
- Quebec health insurance card
- Canadian passport
- Certificate of Indian status
- Canadian Forces ID card


### YOUR NAME IS MISSING OR INCORRECT?

You must go in person to the Board of Revisors (for domiciled voters only) to request a registration, removal, or correction. A parent, spouse, or someone living with you can make the request on your behalf.

To register or change your address, you must present two documents:

- ✓ One showing your name and date of birth  
*E.g. passport, birth certificate, health insurance card, etc.*
- ✓ One showing your name and current home address  
*E.g. driver's licence, phone or utility bill, student card, etc.*

Voting locations are accessible to everyone. Election staff on site will be available to assist you throughout the voting process.


You may also request an accessibility kit, which includes tools designed to help make your voting experience easier.
