Important to know

Possibility of low water Pressure

While all precautions to avoid disrupting the network's continuous supply are taken, these operations could cause a **drop in water pressure, on April 9, between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.**

Possibility of discoloured water

Yellowish, brownish or reddish colour. **See reverse for instructions before consuming water.**

Affected areas

Dollard-des-Ormeaux : within the following limits

- South of Boulevard de Salaberry
- East of Rue Somerset
- West of Rue Iberville and Rue Tecumseh

Pointe-Claire : northern sector, bounded by

- Boulevard Hymus
- Avenue Delmar
- Avenue Saint-Louis.

Kirkland : throughout the city

Baie-D'Urfé : throughout the city

À noter

These disruptions may occur at various times and does not usually last very long. If it persists beyond the above-mentioned period, call 311.

Area affected by the potential low water pressure and discoloured water



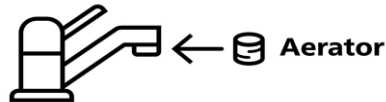
Steps to follow if your water is discoloured

Turn on your cold water tap.

- Preferably the bathtub tap, otherwise the kitchen sink tap. If your property has neither a bathtub nor a kitchen sink (because it is a shop, for example), use whatever tap you have available.
- Let the cold water run until it becomes clear again.
- Your tap water can then be consumed.

Does your tap have an aerator?

- Before letting the water run, it is recommended to unscrew the nozzle to remove it.



Important

- To avoid staining fabrics or damaging your appliances, make sure the water is clear before doing your laundry or using an appliance that uses water.
