## **Possibility of discoloured water and low water pressure**



### **Important to know**

#### **Low water pressure**

- While all precautions to avoid disrupting the network's continuous supply are taken, these operations could cause a drop in water pressure on **Thursday October 17, between 12 p.m. and 6 p.m.**

#### **Possibility of discoloured water**

- Yellowish, brownish or reddish colour.
- See reverse for instructions before consuming water.
- These disruptions may occur at various times and does not usually last very long.
- If it persists beyond the above-mentioned period, call 311.

#### **Affected areas**

- Baie-D'Urfé, Kirkland, Pointe-Claire (sector delimited by Boulevard Hymus, Avenue Delmar and Avenue Saint-Louis) and Dollard-des-Ormeaux (sector delimited by Boulevard de Salaberry, Rue Sommerset, Rue Iberville and Rue Tecumseh).

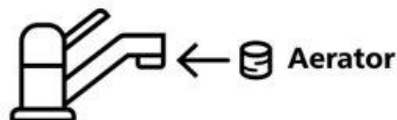
## Steps to follow if your water is discoloured

### Turn on your cold water tap

- Preferably the bathtub tap, otherwise the kitchen sink tap. If your property has neither a bathtub nor a kitchen sink (because it is a shop, for example), use whatever tap you have available.
- Let the cold water run until it becomes clear again.
- Your tap water can then be consumed.

### Does your tap have an aerator?

- Before letting the water run, it is recommended to unscrew the nozzle to remove it



### Important

- To avoid staining fabrics or damaging your appliances, make sure the water is clear before doing your laundry or using an appliance that uses water.
