## D. TOWN PLANNING

1. Request for subdivision permit for lot no. 1 558 306 at 21 rue Beechwood.

WHEREAS a subdivision permit application to divide lot no. 1558306, located at 21 rue Beechwood, to create lots nos. 5902274 and 5902275 has been submitted to the Town;

WHEREAS this cadastral operation requires that the applicant make a contribution of land to the Town which, in the opinion of the Council, is suitable for the establishment or enlargement of a park or playground or for the preservation of a natural area and/or that the owner pays an amount to the Town calculated according to the rules established in Section 2.3 of Subdivision By-law no. 876; and

WHEREAS the property owners of 21 rue Beechwood wish to transfer the land on proposed lot no. 5 902 275 to the Town so that it may be incorporated into the adjacent park;

**2016-06-151** THEREFORE, it is moved by Councillor Janet Ryan, seconded by Councillor Charles Colomb to accept the transfer of a portion of proposed lot no. 5 902 275 equal to 10% of the total gross area of the land affected by the cadastral operation as a parcel of land suitable for the enlargement of a park, in order to satisfy the conditions for the approval of the cadastral operation, as established in Section 2.3 of Subdivision By-law no. 876.

2. <u>Authorization to sign the Property Donation Agreement for proposed lot no. 5 902 275 located at</u> 21 rue Beechwood

WHEREAS the property owners of 21 rue Beechwood have applied for a demolition permit;

WHEREAS the plans submitted with the demolition permit application will not be in conformity with the Town Planning By-laws unless lot no. 1 558 306 is subdivided and the enclaved portion of the land is rezoned and incorporated into the adjacent park;

WHEREAS the property owners of 21 rue Beechwood wish to donate the proposed enclaved lot to the Town so that it may be incorporated into the adjacent park;

WHEREAS the donation of land is conditional upon the adoption of the final by-law amendments to the Zoning and Subdivision By-laws that are required to make this project conform to Town Planning By-laws and upon the issuance of the demolition permit by the Town; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to clarify the obligations of both parties with respect to the donation of land to be made to the Town;

**2016-06-152** THEREFORE, it is moved by Councillor Janet Ryan, seconded by Councillor Charles Colomb to authorize the Director of Town Planning to sign, on behalf of the Town of Baie-D'Urfé, the Property Donation Agreement with the owners of the property located at 21 rue Beechwood.

1. <u>Authorization to sign agreement with Canadian Coast Guard Auxiliary (Quebec) inc.</u>

WHEREAS the Town wishes to offer coast guard patrol services on its territory and for its nautical clubs;

WHEREAS the Canadian Coast Guard Auxiliary Quebec inc. through its Unit 8 has been offering coast guard patrol services since 2013;

WHEREAS in exchange for these services, the Town has agreed to give the Canadian Coast Guard Auxiliary Quebec inc. an annual financial contribution of \$4000;

WHEREAS the Town wishes to renew its agreement with the Canadian Coast Guard Auxiliary Quebec inc. which mandates Unit 8 to gives services on the Town's territory;

**2016-06-155** THEREFORE, it is moved by Councillor Lynda Phelps seconded by Councillor Brian Manning and UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED to authorize the Town's director general to sign the 2016-2018 agreement with the Canadian Coast Guard Auxiliary Quebec inc. for coast guard services on the Town's territory.
