## Streetlights Replacement

### BAIE-D'URFÉ: A TOWN ENLIGHTED... SUSTAINABLY!

We are proud to announce that, from **November 6 to December 15, 2017**, we will be carrying out our project to modernize the street lighting network. A total of **782** lights will be converted to light-emitting diode (LED) technology and controlled by an intelligent management system.

In addition to offering improved and optimal lighting for the safety of all users of our roadways, LED technology is also recognized as being energy efficient. The Town's electricity bill will be reduced by **75%**, or **\$50,500** per year. Note that LED technology offers directional lighting to help reduce light pollution. In addition, thanks to a selection of "Dark Sky-certified" products, light pollution will be practically eliminated.

Our street lighting network will be enhanced by an intelligent control system that will allow us to manage all of our lights remotely and in real time. As a result of the work, we will save **\$19,550** in annual maintenance costs.
