

## ACCESSORY BUILDING – DOCUMENT CHECKLIST RESIDENTIAL

Any construction or modification to an accessory building requires a building permit.
1- Form completed and signed by the property owner or their representative 2- A letter of authorization, if the applicant represents the owner 3- Proof of ownership 4- In case of co-ownership, a letter of authorization from the association of co-owners 5- Descriptive letter of the scope of work 6- Photos in color of the facades of building 7- Copy of the certificate of location 8- If it is a new or a dislocation or an extension of an accessory building, submit:  - Existing and proposed plans to scale, dimensioned in meter showing: lot lines, setbacks, all existing building(s), structures, driveway and impermeable surface - Calculation of existing and proposed impermeable surface - Location of the septic tank system 9- If it is an accessory building replacement without increasing its surface, submit: - Existing site plan - Photos in color of the existing accessory building - Elevations or drawings of the accessory building indicating its dimensions - Photo du bâtiment accessoire à construire et des matériaux proposés
Important: Site plans that are not prepared by a land surveyor have to be prepared with reference to the up-to date plan of the certificate of location.  10- Cost estimate of work  11- Applicable fees: \$20

Please note that depending on the nature and complexity of the project, the Town of Baie d'Urfé reserves the right to require any other document necessary in order to establish a better understanding of the project and ensure its compliance with all applicable regulations.
