

BOIL ADVISORY!



These instructions are in effect until further notice.



Bring tap water to a rolling boil for at least ONE minute or use bottled water when:

- Drinking or preparing beverages
- Preparing baby bottles/food
- Washing and preparing foods to be eaten raw (fruits, vegetables, etc.)
- Preparing foods that do not require prolonged cooking times
- Making ice cubes
- Brushing your teeth/rinsing your mouth

Unboiled tap water can be used when:

- Washing dishes in hot water (make sure you wipe them thoroughly dry)
- Doing the laundry
- Taking a shower or bath (make sure young children do not swallow any of the water)

WATER AVOIDANCE



ADVISORY



The Town of Baie-D'Urfé advises against using tap water even if it has been boiled.

A sample analysis indicates that the water in your area is not currently fit for use.

Tap water **MUST NOT** be used to prepare beverages, baby bottle, food or ice cubes. **DO NOT** brush your teeth, rinse your mouth or wash your hands with tap water.

Food establishments **MUST NOT** use tap water for cleaning their equipment or facilities.

Hot water can be used for :

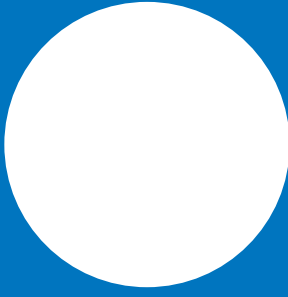
- Washing dishes in hot water (make sure you wipe them thoroughly dry)
- Doing the laundry
- Taking a shower or bath (make sure young children do not swallow any of the water)

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WATER SYSTEM FLUSHING



ANNUAL MAINTENANCE PROGRAM



For a two weeks period, The Town of Baie-D'Urfé will proceed with the inspection and flushing of its water distribution system in the residential sector.

While this work is done, you may experience a slight red coloring of the water. Although this is not dangerous, we recommend that you verify to ensure that your water is not colored before using it. If this is the case, simply let the cold water run until it becomes clear.

Do not forget to flush the water in your washing machine before doing the laundry. Through this period low water pressure shouldn't occur.

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IMPORTANT NOTICE

TEMPORARY UNAVAILABILITY OF DRINKING WATER



This temporary interruption of drinking water service is required because of work being carried out in your area.

We are making every possible effort to restore normal service quickly.

If your water is cloudy or coloured after service is restored, run the cold water until it is clear again.

Once service is restored bring tap water to a rolling boil for a least one minute or use bottled water when :

- Drinking or preparing beverages
- Preparing baby bottles/food
- Washing and preparing foods to be eaten raw (fruits,vegetables, etc.)
- Preparing foods that do not require prolonged cooking times
- Making ice cubes
- Brushing your teeth/rinsing your mouth

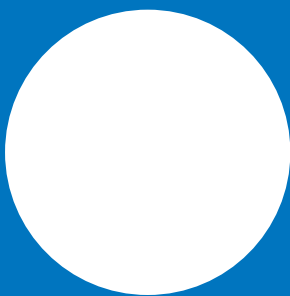

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END OF BOILING ADVISORY



The Town of Baie-D'Urfé advises you that tap water can now be used.

The most recent water analyses confirm that the situation has returned to normal.

Recommendations

We recommend discarding any ice cubes, beverages or food that were prepared with unboiled water after receipt of the Boil Advisory.

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
